The Committee on Curriculum has sent the following recommendations to the Academic Senate:

Revised Course

DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES AND LITERATURES

From: LC-121 Elementary Mandarin I for Students of Chinese Heritage
4 class hours 4 credits
[Prerequisite/corequisites: Departmental permission.]

To: LC-121 Elementary Mandarin I for Students of Chinese Heritage
4 class hours 4 credits
Prerequisite/corequisites: None

Rationale:

Many students of Chinese heritage have registered for LC111 because the prerequisite of LC121 prevents them from registering for it. The prerequisite should be removed since the course title and its description clearly explain who should take this course.

Addendum:

The Curriculum Committee withdrew, from its February 2014 report, a new concentration proposed by the Department of Health, Physical Education and Dance (**Parks, Recreation and Leisure Studies- PRLS**) to have a chance to address some administrative concerns. The Curriculum Committee discussed the concentration again during its meeting of March 18, 2014, and suggested revisions. In the meantime, the Curriculum Committee has approved the four courses created for this concentration as experimental, and has encouraged the HPED Department to submit the revised concentration in the near future. The four experimental courses approved are the following:

PE-841: Camp Leadership
2 hours, 2 credits

PE-842: Philosophy of Coaching
1 credit, 2 hours

PE-843: Introduction to Team Sport
2 credits, 2 hours

PE-844: Principles of Cross Training
2 credits, 2 hours
