Are you aware that your Cengage, Pearson and McGraw-Hill content is available to be added to your courses from within Blackboard? A separate sign-in is no longer needed for students!

What's New in Blackboard?

Blackboard upgrade is currently scheduled to begin on Thurs, December 27th at 6:00 am and to be completed by the close of business on Fri, December 28th. Blackboard will be taken offline and there will be no access to the environment during the upgrade. The downtime required for the upgrade necessitates that the work be performed in the week between the Christmas and New Year's holidays as this is the only time when classes are not in session on any CUNY campus. We encourage all faculty to submit grades as early as possible. However, we recommend that faculty download assignments and grade data from their courses should they need access to that information while the system is unavailable.
